Cancer Drop In Centre: Aileen McClymont the newly appointed manager of the cancer drop in centre gave an interesting talk on what it provides to cancer patients and their families in this area. The centre was founded about 20 years ago, with a mixture of staff and volunteers. It is a registered charity starting off in Mill Hill Street Stranraer and now moved to the Waverly medical centre. They provide 1 to 1 support and group support. They also can help you with financial support with information on benefits and grants available for cancer patients that are unable to work through being to unwell or receiving treatment, the centre is also there to support family members and carers with any questions they have for their love ones who is going through cancer. They also offer coffee mornings, knitting groups and walking groups. Transport is also available to help patients get to hospital appointments. If you would like to pop in for a chat they are open Wednesdays, Thursdays and Fridays 10.00am to 3.00pm.

3. Correspondence: Cubs and Beavers applied to the micro grant scheme for a grant of £500.00 towards there hall fees, equipment and stationary and also to treat the children to the local pantomime. Jane Dodds removed herself from the hall while the voting commenced everyone was in agreement to the £500.00. Glenluce Primary School applied to the micro grant for assistance in travel and accommodation costs for a school trip to Carlingwark in Castle Douglas. The total cost is £50.00 per child the council used to provide support towards the cost but do not anymore. The requested amount was £410.00 and they also requested to Newluce Community Council for the same amount. Which will bring the cost down to £30.00 per child for the parents to pay. The voting commenced and everyone was in agreement. Glenluce Primary School also applied for another micro grant for £410.00 towards the cost of taking the school to the pantomime every one voted in agreement. Glen of Luce Woman's Institute applied to the micro grant for there hall fees of £144.00 with everyone voting in agreement.

Christmas Parties: Saturday 22nd December will be the date for both Christmas parties. Julie McKie will be doing the children's party and will also be providing entertainment to the adults with her singing at night. The big Christmas switch on is Saturday 1st December at 5pm with carol singing, mulled wine and short bread starting from 4.15pm.

Reports: Ian Paterson asked if the 100 club draw for December, January and the Christmas draw can be done at the Christmas party everyone agreed.

5.Development Trust: Mike gave an update on the trust they have had 3 grants approved for the car parks, projector system and 5 acres in the glen. Outside sockets was installed for the Christmas decorations with more light this year with even lights on the trees at the top of the village. The Visitor square is looking for tenders to do it out. The hall has a disabled ramp being installed, a mop sink and new curtains. There is also new cinema equipment but Freddie highlighted the hall needs more security. The next trusts AGM is on Wednesday 28th November.
